Enjoy a beautiful autumn in Seneca County, see the famous white deer and listen to the secrets of the military history of the former Seneca Army Depot. Fun for the entire family!

Tours last approximately two hours and will be by bus only. No private cars are allowed. Don't delay in registering as both previous tours sold out very quickly!

Some highlights of our tours include:

- **NEW for this tour!** Visit **INSIDE** an igloo and experience the history it housed...see the 519 cement igloo/bunkers that housed the ammunitions for our past wars, built in 7 months in the early 1940's.
- The cemetery, where the remains of former Kendaia area residents and soldiers of Sullivan's Campaign are buried.
- The conservation area, which is home to bald eagles, turkeys, owls, hawks, and much more wildlife.
- The 'Q' area, the most highly classified area for the Army, and home to the nuclear arms.
- The site of the Women's Peace Encampment, where in 1983, many participants were arrested after climbing over the barbed wire fence to protest the use and storage of nuclear munitions at the Depot.
 - And...of course, the treasured white deer, the largest herd in the world, living within a fenced area of 10,000 acres last count, about 200!
Watch them....watching you! A truly unique treasure!

Directions to the Varick VFD for the Fall Tours

Please arrive early to check in and check out our exhibits and gift items for sale. The Varick VFD will be selling soft drinks and food on all Saturdays and Sundays

From the West: Take NYS Thruway to the Geneva Exit (#42) and travel south on NYS 14. Look for signs for Rts 5&20 going East. Follow Rts 5&20 past the state park at the north end of Seneca Lake and just past the park turn right onto Rt 96A. Go 6.2 miles and the Varick VFD is on your right side. It is a large building with a red metal roof.

From the East: Take NYS Thruway to the Waterloo Exit (#41) and take Rt 414 south to the intersection of Rts 5&20. Turn right at light and go thru village of Waterloo and proceed for about five miles. You will see a Lowe's on your right and a stop light. Turn left at the stop light and go 6.2 miles to the Varick VFD which will be on your right. It is a large building with a red metal roof.

From the South: From Ithaca travel north on Rt 96. Once you reach Ovid, follow Rt 96A north for about 10 miles. You will actually go past part of the Depot (on your right side) and the Varick VFD will be on your left side past the entrance (.5 miles) of the Hillside Children's Center. It is a large building with a red metal roof.
